VIII. Instructions for Completing Application

Make checks payable to "Alger County Building Codes"

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the permit has been issued by Alger County Building Codes. All installations shall be in compliance with the Michigan Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible and provide the **job location, permit number, and contact information. Schedule permitting, the inspector will respond to an inspection request within two (2) business days to schedule the inspection. Inspections are typically performed within five (5) business days subject to the inspection schedule.**

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00.**
