

**ALGER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING**

March 9, 2026

Approved April 20, 2026

The Alger County Board of Commissioners convened in the conference room of the county building at 4:02 p.m. on the above date.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Seaberg with the following commissioners present: Commissioners Hughes, Livermore, Nettleton, Rondeau, and Seaberg. Absent – none.

The board of commissioners said the Pledge of Allegiance.

The public comment session was open. There was no public comment; thus, the public comment session was closed.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the agenda as presented.

Nick Derusha, LMAS District Health Department Executive Director gave presented the LMAS 2025 Annual Report.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the bid from Cross General Contracting for courthouse renovations.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the electrical RFP to connect the courthouse generator to the jail.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the airport liability payment for \$3,531.00.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the Letter of Support for Alger County Fair 2% funding request to Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the letter to CAAM requesting an annual report.

It was the consensus of the board to approve reposting notice of vacancy on the county website through Friday, March 13.

The Board discussed temporary committee reassignments.

It was the consensus of the board to approve all board bills as recommended by the Audit Committee.

It was the consensus of the board to approve the financial reports for all funds (Trial Balance Report Available).

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the clerk to transfer \$145,510.63 between FY2025 General Fund budgets (see sheet).

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the clerk and treasurer to amend FY2025 funds budgets (see sheet).

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the treasurer to transfer \$32,445.39 from FY2025 General Fund to FY2025 Sheriff Funds (see sheet).

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the treasurer to transfer \$4,553.12 from Veterans Relief Millage Fund #293 to Veterans Trust Fund #294 for expenses not covered by the State Veterans Grant.

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the treasurer to transfer General Fund revenues received in 2026 for expenses paid in 2025 in the amount of \$129,460.55 (see sheet).

It was the consensus of the board to authorize the treasure to transfer accounts receivable revenue for FY2025 funds.

It was the consensus of the board to approve resolution #2026-03 Authorizing Resolution Approving Application for a Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) for homeowner housing rehabilitation and authorizing submittal of the MI-Neighborhood Grant Application to the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA).

Commissioner Rondeau reported that LMAS is opposing septic oversight legislation. Commissioner Hughes heard Pathways CEO agency report to lobby for addition state funding.

Correspondence was briefly read and placed on file.

Commissioner Rondeau said he is disappointed to see Commissioner Livermore leave and Commissioners Nettleton and Hughes said their appreciations. Commissioner Livermore spoke about how much she has learned and has come to appreciate all the work that the board does.

The public comment session was open. It was noted that last year's LMAS report is in the meeting packet. The clerk will replace it. There was no further public comment; thus, the public comment session was closed.

The Chairman adjourned this meeting at 4:43 p.m.
